Egypt: A World Heritage Tour

Discover the World Heritage Sites of Egypt





DAY 1 CAIRO Arrival. We are welcomed at the airport and transferred to our hotel.

DAY 2 CAIRO We explore the Sphinx and Great Pyramids of Giza and visit the Egyptian Museum. Optional camel rides in Giza.

DAY 3 CAIRO Full day excusion to visit Memphis*, Saqqara* and the Pyramids of Dahshur*.

DAY 4 CAIRO We explore Historic Cairo* including Khan al-Khalili Bazaar.

DAY 5 CAIRO • ABU SIMBEL - NILE **CRUISE • ASWAN** Short flights take us to visit the temples of Abu Simbel* and Aswan, where we board our Nile cruise ship. We visit the High Dam, the Granite Quarries, the Temple of Philae* and sail the Nile on a traditional felucca.

DAY 6 NILE CRUISE: EDFU • ESNA We sail to Kom Ombo to visit the Temple of Sobek and continue sailing until Edfu, where we visit the Horus Temple by horse carriage and then sail through to Esna.

DAY 7 NILE CRUISE: ESNA • LUXOR

We sail to Luxor to explore the Necropolis of Ancient Thebes* on the West Bank of the Nile with visits to the Colossi of Memnon, the Valley of Kings and the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut. Optional Sound & Light show in Karnak.

DAY 8 LUXOR • SHARM EL-SHEIKH We visit the Karnak Temple Complex and the Temple of Luxor before our transfer to the airport for our flight to Sharm el-Sheikh.

DAY 9 SHARM EL-SHEIKH • **ST. CATHERINE** We have all day to relax at this world-class resort before our night journey to St. Catherine.

DAY 10 ST. CATHERINE • SHARM EL-SHEIKH We begin our Mount Sinai hike to catch the sunrise. After our descent we visit the Monastery of St. Catherine* and return to Sharm el-Sheikh. Afternoon free.

DAY 11 SHARM EL-SHEIKH • CAIRO Flight to Cairo, followed by an exploration of Coptic Cairo and the Ben Ezra Synagogue.

DAY 12 CAIRO • BAHARIYA OASIS We travel to Bahariya Oasis to visit the Golden Mummies Museum and the surrounding temples and tombs, ending our day with a bath in the hot water springs.

DAY 13 BLACK DESERT • WHITE DESERT We explore the Black Desert, the White Desert and Crystal Mountain.

DAY 14 WADI AL-HITAN • FAIYUM OASIS We drive to Wadi El Rayyan and continue to the valley of Wadi Al-Hitan*, one of the world's most important

paleontological sites. The journey day ends in Faiyum Oasis.

DAY 15 FAIYUM OASIS • ALEXANDRIA We visit the Karanis archaeological site and the Pyramid at Meidum, the Monastery of the Syrians in Wadi el Natrun, before our arrival in Alexandria. Evening free.

DAY 16 ALEXANDRIA We visit the Catacombs of Kom El Shokafa, Pompey's Pillar and the Roman Amphitheatre, Quaitbay Fortress, Montazah Park and the new Bibliotheca Alexandrina and the early Christian holy city of Abu Mena* (Subject to permit). Evening free.

DAY 17 CAIRO After our incredible journey of marvelling at Egypt's cultural and natural heritage, we are transferred to the Cairo Airport.

DAY 1 CAIRO Arrival. We are welcomed at the airport and transferred to our hotel.

DAU 2 CAIRO • PYRAMIDS We drive to the Necropolis of Giza* and explore the Great Sphinx of Giza and the Great Pyramids, followed by an excursion to Memphis and its Necropolis* and, the necropolis of Saqqara*.

DAY 3 CAIRO • LUXOR Exploration of Coptic Cairo, including visits to the Hanging Church of the Virgin Mary and the Ben Ezra Synagogue. In the evening board your deluxe overnight train to Luxor.

DAU 4 NILE CRUISE: LUXOR Upon arrival, transfer to your Nile River cruise ship, your home for the next four nights. We start our exploration of Ancient Thebes* with visits of the Karnak Temple Complex and the Temple of Luxor on the East Bank of the Nile.

Optional Excursions:

• Dendera Temple Complex, including the Hathor Temple, the Temple of the birth of Isis and the Christian Basilica.

• Experience the Sound and Light show at Karnak Temple in the evening, as you wander around the illuminated monuments and towering obelisks.

DAY 5 NILE CRUISE: LUXOR • ESNA

• **EDFU** We explore the Necropolis of Ancient Thebes* on the West Bank of the Nile with visits to the Colossi of Memnon, the Valley of Kings and the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut. We then sail to Esna, cross the lock then continue to Edfu.

DAU 6 NILE CRUISE: EDFU • KOM OMBO • ASWAN We visit the Temple of Horus in Edfu, followed by an afternoon river journey to visit the Temple of Kom Ombo and continue to sail to Aswan.

DAU 7 NILE CRUISE: ASWAN Upon arrival in Aswan we visit the High Dam, the Granite Quarries with the Unfinished Obelisk and the Temple of Philae*. In the afternoon, we take a ride on a felucca around Elephantine Island and the Aga Khan Mausoleum.

Abu Simbel Optional Excursion

This short trip is by air from Aswan and includes a guided tour of the Abu Simbel Temples*. This excursion is taken immediately after arrival in Aswan. The Aswan excursions will proceed upon your return. **DAU 8 ASWAN • CAIRO** After a short flight, we explore Historic Cairo* visiting the Citadel with the Mohammed Ali Mosque, the Sultan Hassan & Al-Rifa'i Mosques, Beit El Suhaymi, the Old Gates of Cairo and Khan al-Khalili Bazaar.

DAU 9 CAIRO After our incredible journey of marvelling at Egypt's cultural and natural heritage, we are transferred to the airport.

DAY 1 CAIRO Arrival. We are welcomed at the airport and transferred to our hotel.

DAU 2 CAIRO We drive to the Necropolis of Giza* and explore the Great Sphinx of Giza and the Great Pyramids. Afternoon free.

DAU 3 CAIRO Half day tour to visit the Egyptian Museum of Antiquities housing the collection of King Tutankhamun. Free afternoon.

DAU 4 CAIRO • ABU SIMBEL Flight to Abu Simbel. We are transferred to our cruise ship on Lake Nasser, our accommodation for the next 4 nights. In the afternoon, we explore the temples of Abu Simbel*.

DAU 5 LAKE NASSER CRUISE On our cruise we visit the fortress of Qasr Ibrim and the Temple of Amada, considered to be the oldest Egyptian temple in Nubia.

DAU 6 LAKE NASSER CRUISE Cruising along Lake Nasser we visit the temples of Wadi es-Sebua and Dakka.

DAY 7 LAKE NASSER CRUISE • ASWAN

We visit the Kalabsha Temple, the rock cut temple of Beit El Wali, the Philae Temple Complex * and see the Aswan High Dam. In the afternoon we visit a Nubian Village and the Botanical Garden by felucca.

DAU 8 ASWAN • NILE CRUISE We visit the Nubian Museum before we are transferred to the Nile Cruise ship, our home for the next 4 nights. In the afternoon we sail by felucca around Elephantine Island & Agha Khan Mausoleum.

DAU 9 NILE CRUISE: ASWAN • KOM OMBO • **EDFU** Morning free before sailing to Kom Ombo along the River Nile.

DAY 10 NILE CRUISE: EDFU • ESNA We visit the Horus Temple in Edfu by horse carriage and then sail through the Esna Locks on the Nile River to Luxor.

DAY 11 NILE CRUISE: LUXOR We explore Ancient Thebes and its Necropolis *, including visits to the Valley of the Kings, the funerary temple of Queen Hatshepsut, the Colossi of Memnon, the Karnak Temple and the Temple of Luxor.

DAU 12 LUXOR • CAIRO We visit the Luxor Museum and the Mummification Museum, before boarding our overnight sleeper train to Cairo.

DAU 13 CAIRO • ALEXANDRIA After our arrival in Cairo we drive via the fascinating Desert Road to Alexandria and visit the Catacombs of Kom El Shokafa, Pompey's Pillar and the Roman Amphitheatre. Evening free.

DAY 14 ALEXANDRIA • CAIRO

We continue our exploration of Alexandria, visiting Quaitbay Fortress, Montazah Park and the new Bibliotheca Alexandrina. In the afternoon we return to Cairo.

DAU 15 CAIRO After our incredible journey of marvelling at Egypt's cultural and natural heritage, we are transferred to the airport.



DAU 1 CAIRO Arrival. We are welcomed at the airport and transferred to our hotel.

DAU 2 CAIRO We drive to the Necropolis of Giza* and explore the Great Sphinx of Giza and the Great Pyramids. In the afternoon we visit the Egyptian Museum. Optional camel rides in Giza.

DAU 3 CAIRO • BAHARIYA OASIS

We travel to Bahariya Oasis, known historically as the Northern Oasis. In the afternoon we tour the Oasis, English Mountain and the museum that houses the recently excavated Golden Mummies, the funerary temple of Baouiti, the tombs of Bannenteoui & Zed Amoun, the Temple of Alexander the Great and the Temple of Bess. We conclude the day with a bath in the hot water springs.

DAU 4 BAHARIYA OASIS • BLACK DESERT • WHITE DESERT We travel by 4 wheel drive to explore the Black Desert, region of volcano-shaped mountains with large quantities of small black stones, followed by the contrasting White Desert with its unusual rock formations set against the pale yellow sand and Crystal Mountain, with its glittering calcite crystal walls. We spend the night in a tented camp gazing at the stars.

DAY 5 WHITE DESERT • CAIRO

We return from the White Desert to Cairo. Afternoon at leisure.

DAU 6 CAIRO • LUXOR We take a short flight to Luxor to explore Ancient Thebes with its Necropolis*, including visits to the Valley of the Kings, the funerary temple of Queen Hatshepsut at Deir El Bahari, the Colossi of Memnon, the Karnak Temple Complex and the Temple of Luxor.

DAU 7 LUXOR • DENDERA We travel by boat north towards Quena, to explore the Hathor Temple, the Temple of the birth of Isis and the Christian Basilica in Dendera and sail back to Luxor.

DAU 8 LUXOR • ASWAN We drive from Luxor to Aswan, including visits of the Horus Temple in Edfu and the Kom Ombo Temple. In the afternoon we visit a Nubian Village and the Botanical Gardens by felucca.

DAU 9 ASWAN We visit the High Dam, the Granite Quarries with the Unfinished Obelisk, the Temple of Philae* and the Nubian Museum.

DAY 10 ASWAN • CAIRO Free morning at leisure, followed by an afternoon flight to Cairo.




